

Period #1—49 years (Dan. 9:25). During this period, the Jews will rebuild the City of Jerusalem in troubled times.

Period #2—483 years (Dan. 9:25). Gabriel affirmed that 483 years are involved from the giving of the decree to the coming of "the Anointed One, the ruler" ($7 \times 7 = 49$; $7 \times 62 = 434$; total = 483).

From March 14, 445 BC to April 6, 32 BC = 483 years.

THE INTERVAL - THE TIME BETWEEN THE 69TH AND THE 70TH WEEK

And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined. **Daniel 9:26**

The Interval is clear that this is the "Church Age".

HERE ARE THE SIX THINGS TO BE ACCOMPLISHED:

(Three parts having to do with sin and three having to do with righteousness.)

1. "**To finish transgression.**" This refers to the transgression of Israel. The cross provided the redemption for sin; for the sin of the nation, but not all accepted it. .
2. "**To put and end to sin.**" The national sins of Israel will come to an end at the second coming of Christ. Christ will judge each person on salvation (what they have done with Christ) and also based on their works (rewards). We know God and enter into heaven based on trusting in Jesus for salvation, we receive rewards based on our heart and obedience for the Lord.
3. "**To atone for wickedness.**" During this period of Seventy Weeks, God has provided redemption through the death and resurrection of Christ. This, of course, is for Jew and Gentile alike.
4. "**To bring in everlasting righteousness.**" This refers to the return of Christ at the end of the 490 years to establish the Kingdom. God will rule and do away, in time, with all sin and sinfulness.
5. "**To seal up vision and prophecy**" means that all will be fulfilled, which will vindicate this prophecy as well as all other prophecies in Scripture.
6. "**To anoint the most Holy**" has reference to the anointing of the Holy of Holies in the Millennial Temple about which Ezekiel spoke (Ezek. 41 - Ezek. 46).

By knowing these Truths, history and knowing God's Word, we are to:

- 1) **Love God**
- 2) **Love Others**
- 3) **Serve**
